



Global events moved very quickly for us in March as we scrambled to attain tickets for our return home on March 13th after our flight for the 17th was cancelled. We arrived at O'Hare 3 hours before the travel ban went into effect. Upon returning to our home, we were under a two week quarantine which was followed up by the statewide shut down.

During this time we have remained active by doing a few Zoom meetings with the church in Malta, helping with evangelism here in Wisconsin and most recently, filling in for the pastor of Abundant Life Church in Two Rivers for several weeks after his family experienced a positive Covid-19 test and went into quarantine. Sister Stevens produced and sent eight children's Bible story videos to the Sunday School children in Malta to help them during their shut down.

In the interim, we have been raising budget funds through various means with some moderate success. We have also communicated with Steve Rogers, the Wisconsin District Global Missions Director, and have agreed to tentatively schedule meetings with churches beginning in September.

We were excited to recently receive an email from Brother Slaydon informing us that the Global Missions Board had ratified our AMP appointment!

In closing, we rejoiced a few days before our return to the U.S., as a Maltese sister and Sunday School helper for Sister Stevens, who had put off baptism for years, got baptized in Jesus name!
