An *Access Challenged Nation* is a nation or tribe that has been minimally reached or not yet reached with the gospel. We characterize an *ACN* if it meets two out of these three criteria:

- 1) Little or no known, indigenous Apostolic presence
- 2) Challenging visa/immigration policies
- 3) Persecution (political, social, or religious)

The church has always been involved in ACN. In modern times, Apostolic pioneers have worked in cities, nations and people groups that were access challenged, without referring to them as such. However, the ACN initiative was born out of an idea that God placed in the heart of a family who was planting a church in the Middle East. Through the prayers of a small group of new bellievers, God began to open doors into a variety of places. Within less than 2 months, the Lord opened up miraculous opportunities to visit and minister in three very challenging locations: Iran, Libya, and North Korea. These experiences grew their faith and inspired them to believe that NO PLACE and NO PEOPLE are beyond the reach of our God! This may seem obvious, however this cannot be overlooked or neglected. Though we are the hands and feet of Jesus, we cannot save anyone. We must pray that the Lord prepares the way and the hearts of men.

Cultural Study

Take time to study the nation you are burdened for. It can be difficult and intimidating to walk into an unfamiliar nation and we want our workers to be prepared. A step beyond this may be studying to prepare yourself to be integrated into the language of the culture.

Evangelism Development

We strongly encourage you to get involved with evangelism efforts wherever you are currently. Begin teaching Bible studies and talking to people about the gospel. Be in prayer to find someone in your daily life who needs to hear the good news!

GATEWAY NATIONS

While there is no official list, an *ACN* Gateway Nation is a nation that shares some *ACN* characteristics or provides access to people from an *ACN*. For instance, some nations present very challenging security situations, while remaining relatively open for visas and access. Another example is a nation that shares a language and culture with an *ACN*, but is open in regard to evangelism.

ACN Gateway nations change over time, but they provide a mid-range environment in which new workers can learn and grow. Seasoned workers and national leaders in these nations will be able to provide valuable teaching and training to those desiring to work in an ACN.

Where does the word apostello come from?

Apostello is a Greek word used in the New Testament to describe the sending away or appointing of someone to go to a particular place.

APOSTELLO TRAINING

Apostello Training is a pilot program under the umbrella of the NEXT STEPS program hosted by Short-Term Missions.

Apostello is intended to meet the need for well-trained workers to reap the harvest across all of **ACN** through intensive training which will include topics such as spiritual disciplines, cultural understanding, Biblical evangelism concepts, security, logistics and more.

Apostello is for those who have had at least 2 months of AIM experience on the field.

Apostello is taught by seasoned missionaries with experience in a variety of nations and cultures which provide a foundation for **ACN** workers to step into new fields with confidence.

SECURITY and our Theology of Risk

How far are we willing to go to meaningfully share the Gospel with those who have never heard?

The short answer is; **as far as Jesus asks**.

In the New Testament and other examples of the early church, there were defining moments of Spirit-led bold obedience that defied human reason. This record of supreme obedience and sacrifice inspire and inform the church to this day. In that same New Testament and early church, there were also moments when the apostles and believers went into hiding or fled for their lives (Acts 8:1-4). It should be noted that God's purpose and design was served in both instances, for it was through the scattering in Acts 8 that the Gospel reached Samaria.

Our ideal is obedience.

Our theology of risk is grounded in a complete dependence on the leading of the Spirit of God within the believer and through God-ordained spiritual authority in our lives. Suffering for the cause

of Christ and suffering for our own self-willed choices might look the same from the outside, but we believe God judges the heart and the motive, not just the action. We want to live in submission to His will and follow His guidance, for His glory. Our ideal is not martyrdom, it's obedience.
