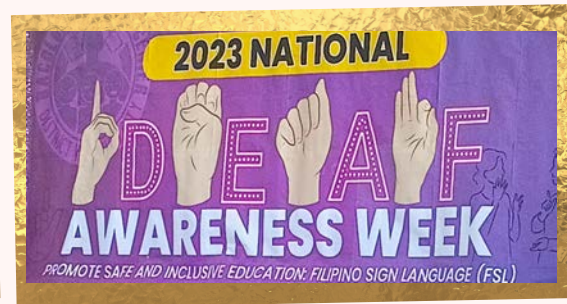
## DEAF MINISTRY IN CEBU
