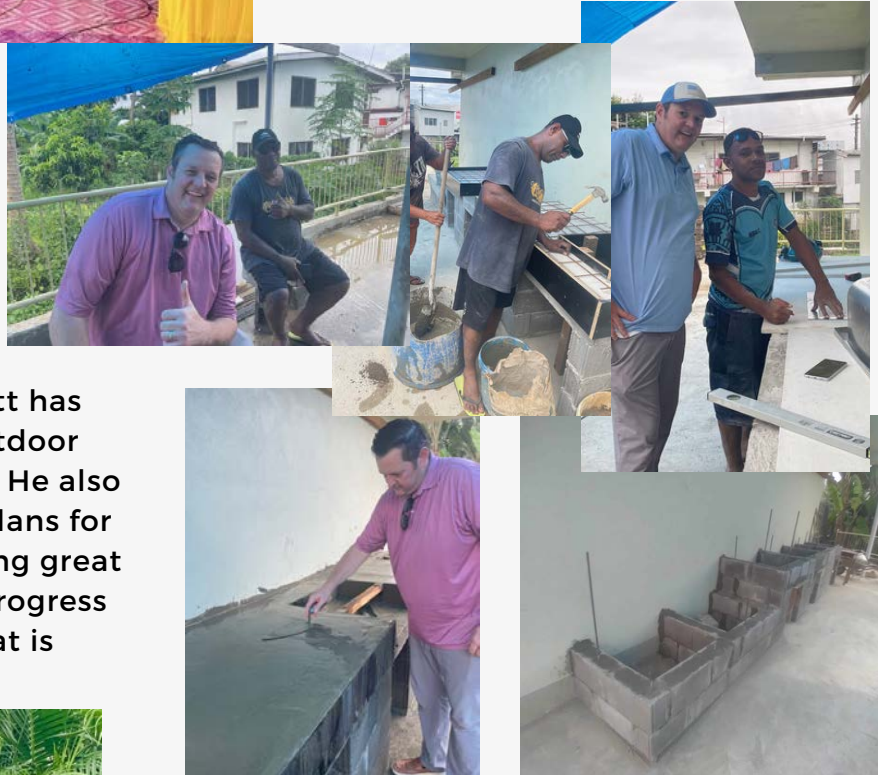
## BIBLE QUIZZING
