Greetings from Barcelona!



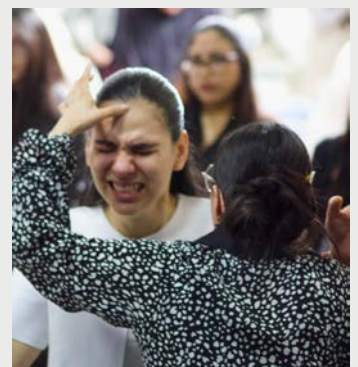
