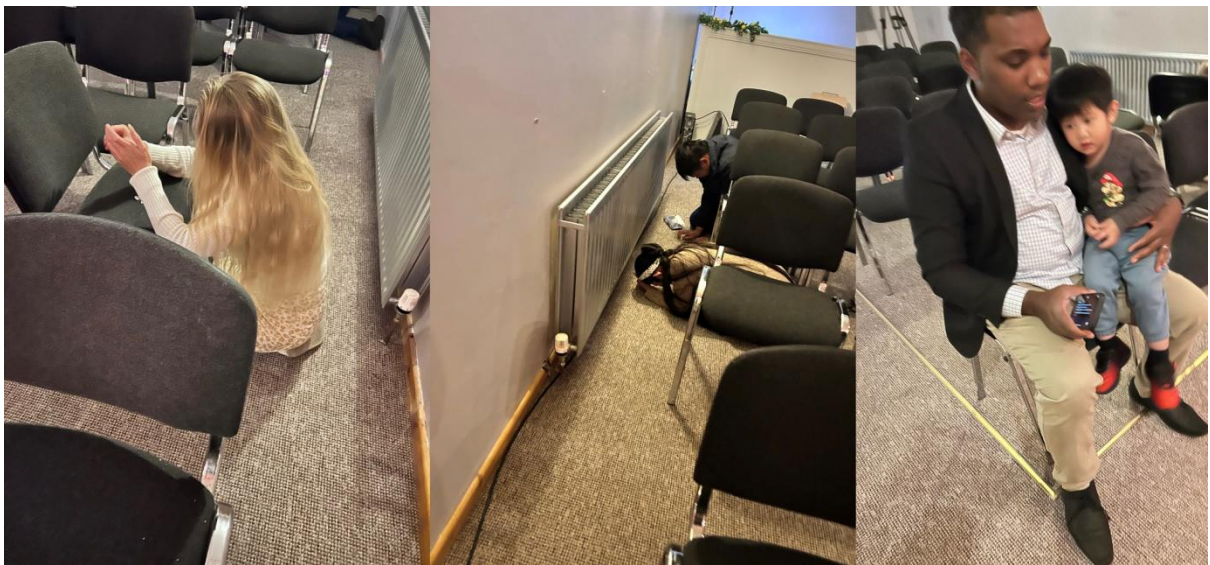


AIM Program
