Breakthrough Among the Deaf at the General Conference

Each year, we observe progress in Deaf Evangelism Ministry at the General Conference. Held in Manila, the final day featured services in 3 districts with 20 Deaf attendees and 25 Deaf in total for the week. Six Deaf and two hearing individuals received the Holy Ghost and 29 interpreters participated in the services.



This month, 6 Deaf were baptized in 5 churches across 4 Districts, along with the six receiving the Holy Ghost at the General Conference. We were in services in 4 Districts.
