

Brittany Stecker August Newsletter Guinea, Africa




My first week was full of new adventures and experience. I connected with one of the Pastors wife, Mama Natasha. She made me feel so welcomed at my first service

In our services we have had people delivered from evil spirit, be filled with the Holy Ghost, be baptized in Jesus name and receive healing.


