We also had our monthly youth service, and Bro. Cole spoke a word of challenge for youth.

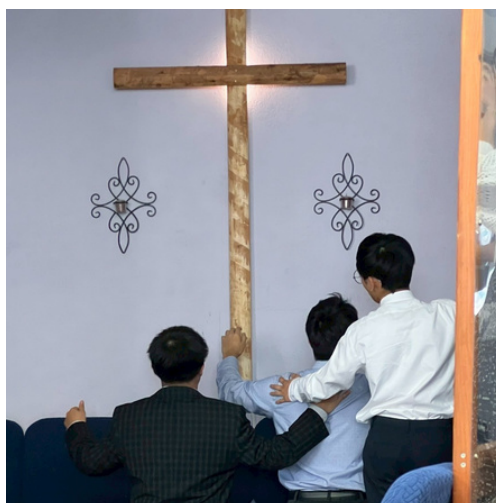
Next month is our church "family camp". We didn't have one last year, but it's always a good time of fellowship together.
