Our first month in Fiji has been incredibly eventful. We had the privilege of participating in the Fiji Sunday school camp, hosted in the central district with the guest speaker evangelist Bro. Justin Hamby. The camp was a powerful success, concluding with 46 children from around Fiji being baptized in Jesus' name and nearly a hundred receiving the Holy Ghost. We also experienced Fiji's Father's Day celebration in September, and during our final week, a missionary from India came to Suva to preach a crusade.



Our primary mission here is to assist with building projects and maintenance. This month, that took us to Dawasamu to see the progress on a new church for a village that lost its building in the 2016 cyclone. We also helped complete a hydroponics greenhouse at the Sawani church, which will grow produce for sale to fund their new building. Back at the headquarters and college, we resolved persistent plumbing leaks and plumbed a new water pump and storage tanks to ensure a reliable water supply during city outages.

It has been a fulfilling and productive first month, and we are excited to see how God continues to work in Fiji through these projects in the months to come.
