Dear Friends and Partners in Missions,

Greetings in Jesus' Name! We are so thankful for each of you and for your continued prayers and support as we are currently home in the United States. This season has been one of fundraising, ministering, and preparing our hearts and plans for our return to the mission field in Brazil—the nation God has clearly called our family to serve through UPCI Global Missions.

This past month has been full and encouraging. We were honored to minister on a Sunday at Southside Community Church in Sacramento, and also at Iglesia Ríos de Agua Viva in Turlock, California. These times of fellowship and worship have strengthened us and reminded us how vital the partnership is between the local church and the work of global missions.

In addition, I was given a unique opportunity to travel to India on a self-supported mission trip for two weeks alongside partner pastors from Los Angeles. Before serving in Brazil, I had the privilege of serving as a missions director at our local church for over twenty years, during which time we helped take teams to India and helped strengthen the ministry. This recent trip allowed us to reconnect, encourage, and support longtime pastor friends, and to check on churches that were established over the years.

While in New Delhi, we ministered with Pastor Paul and Sister Lalam, and in Warangal with Pastor Ravi, in the state of Telangana. In Warangal, we spent meaningful time speaking at a children's home, in Christian school classrooms, and during a church assembly. We then traveled to Andhra Pradesh, ministering in several churches across four villages: Vellagupudi/Tadepalli, Chiluvur, Pedena, and Geddanapalli.

Pastor Clennon and Sister Maria accompanied me on this trip, and together we witnessed God working powerfully in each location. We were able to motivate the church in India about God's work in Brazil. Many of the Pastors in India look forward to one day visiting our churches in Brazil.

Whether in South America or South Asia, the heartbeat is the same—reaching souls, strengthening the church, and caring for God's harvest. The years of ministry experience in India and in the United States, prepared us for our calling and assignment to serve full-time as a family for UPCI Global Missions as Associates in Missions and soon to be in the Associate Missionary Program. The harvest is global, and we are grateful to play our part, especially as we prepare to return to Brazil to continue the work God has entrusted to us.

Thank you for standing with us through prayer, encouragement, and financial support. We truly could not do this without you.
