The resignation was formally approved on December 12<sup>th</sup> by the National Assembly. There have been many demonstrations in the capital city of Sofia since the announcement earlier this year that Bulgaria is joining the Eurozone and adopting the Euro, doing away with the Bulgarian LEV. Much of these demonstrations were led by Gen Z and many of the young people are tired of the corrupt Socialist government and corruption in the state church. This is prime time for us to propagate the Gospel in every sector of Sofia. God is preparing a harvest. We ask for your prayers that when we return to Sofia in February that God would direct us to people who are hungry for the Truth!
