BYM/Pastoral Training Seminar

One of the goals for Bangladesh Youth Ministries (BYM) in 2026 was to hold a pastoral training in January to help pastors and district leaders understand the importance of youth ministry and how to get it started in their churches. After this, as the BYM leader, the goal is to travel to at least one district each month to provide youth worker training and support to the local churches so they can launch their own youth ministries.

In the middle of January, we held a two-day pastoral training seminar on discipleship and youth ministry. Bro. Garcia (a fellow AMP missionary) taught on discipleship, I taught on youth ministry, and several of our pastors led devotions throughout the seminar. We were also able to launch a 52-week discipleship curriculum Bro. Garcia wrote that was translated into Bangla and given to the pastors and leaders at the seminar.

Language School

I began Bangla language school 5 days per week. I am friends with my language teacher on Facebook and she told me she watched our first BYM that was done on FB Live and that she really liked it! My teacher is Muslim, so I am praying that an opportunity to do a Bible study with her will come soon!

Short Highlights

- Attending services every Friday, Saturday, & Sunday in various locations in Dhaka each week.
- Our Tuesday BYM sessions are now being held on Facebook Live instead of zoom. This has allowed more people to join in watching!
- Traveled to Bangkok, Thailand for 4 days for a mandatory 90-day visa exit. I got to eat a DQ blizzard!



Sreepur Home Church

I recently visited our newer UPCB home church in Sreepur, which is about a 2+ hour drive. There was no living room, so we were crowded into a small bedroom and even overflowing into the kitchen. Half of us, including myself, were sitting on the bed while the others brought chairs to sit in. After I taught about receiving the Holy Spirit, we began to pray and ask God to fill us. We thank God for filling 4 people with the Holy Spirit that night!



UPCB Vatara – Youth Ministry Launch

The last Friday in January, we launched the youth ministry in our UPCB church in Vatara, Dhaka. Our first youth service had 19 people and everyone was excited about having services specifically for the youth. We played games, worshipped, and had Word and prayer. I am excited about what God is going to do through this ministry in the future!
