

On February 8th, we preached at a newly rented church building in Sabinas Hidalgo (a mostly catholic city in northern Nuevo León, México). This building has been declared a preaching point and can hold over 300 people! We are believing, through outreach and evangelism, we will soon see a group of believers in Sabinas.

On February 15th, we had our “Friends and Family Day” at our local church with an attendance of over 70 people with Bro. Carlos Sanchez from Venezuela. Following the service, 10 were baptized in Jesus’ name! 🙌🙌🙌 We also enjoyed a time of food and fellowship.

The week of the 16th-20th, we had our national leader conference (CONALID) where Sis. Jenny presented her plans as National Children’s Ministry director and I, Bro. Tony, was voted in as National Missions director and member of the National Board.

Following the conference, we preached in the city of Aguascalientes (central Mexico) where the power of God fell on the church and the altar was filled with tears and tongues. We were scheduled to return home soon after service; however, immediately stepping off the platform we were informed of the national crisis situation where gun fights, fire and drug lords had sat up blockades surrounding the city and we weren’t allowed to leave. (Our location at the time is marked with a green dot on the map.) All land and air travel were cancelled, but early Monday morning we found a taxi that was willing to get us back home to our children whom we had left back home.

In the midst of all the tension and things happening in Mexico, God is still pouring out revival! Thank you for your continued prayers and support—we are declaring souls for His kingdom as we continue to work in Mexico.
