Dear Family, Friends, and Ministry Partners,

Warm greetings in Jesus' name! As we reflect on the month of February, our hearts are filled with gratitude for the goodness of God and for each of you who continue to stand with us as we work toward returning to the mission field in Brazil. The Bible reminds us in Philippians 1:3-5, *"I thank my God upon every remembrance of you, always in every prayer of mine for you all making request with joy, for your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now."* We truly feel this scripture as we think of the many people who have partnered with us in faith and prayer.

We are excited to share that in February we were formally promoted to the Global Missions Associate Missionary Program (AMP) with UPCI Global Missions. This is a significant milestone in our journey and confirms the direction God has given our family for Brazil. We are deeply thankful for the confidence and support shown to us through this opportunity to continue to serve in this capacity in our organization.

During the month of February, we experienced an incredible miracle. A retired pastor prayerfully gave a \$20,000 donation, which was deposited directly into our missions account. We were overwhelmed by this unexpected blessing! Because of this generous gift, we will be able to return to Brazil earlier than anticipated. We are now planning to return to the field the first week of June. God continues to prove that when we walk by faith, He faithfully provides every need.

We have also received our deputation schedule for the UPCI Western District. We will be traveling and presenting the work in Brazil for two weeks in April and two weeks in May. We are excited for the opportunity to connect with churches in the district and share the vision for what God is doing in Brazil and to encourage the body of Christ on these last days.

In February we had the privilege of ministering at Calvary Tabernacle with Pastor Michael Flowers. God moved in a powerful way during the service. We were also blessed to visit our home church, Lighthouse of the Valley, with Pastor Michael Delgado.

Our family was also able to self-fund a trip to Jamaica to attend the United Pentecostal Church Jamaica General Conference. The conference was incredible, and God moved in a powerful way throughout the services. During the conference we were able to connect with Brother David and Sister Yonda Schwarz, Regional Directors for Global Missions in Central America and the Caribbean. It was a meaningful time of fellowship, encouragement, and rest for our family.

Every step forward is a testimony of what God can do when His people unite in faith. Hebrews 11:6 reminds us, *"But without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him."* We are seeing the reward of faith in this season, and we thank God for partners like you who believe in the mission.
