We were so happy, though, to have had our first service at a new location, the Civic Center in Meinohama, a location closer to where we lived. May 10th will always have a warm place in my heart. We will be there more consistently beginning in June. Praise God!

Evangelist Mvmuthu and Sis. Susana were our guest speakers at our May 17th service. He said that healings would occur, and they absolutely did! Praise God! He and his wife are powerful missionaries for the Lord, and we pray for them, in Jesus' name!
