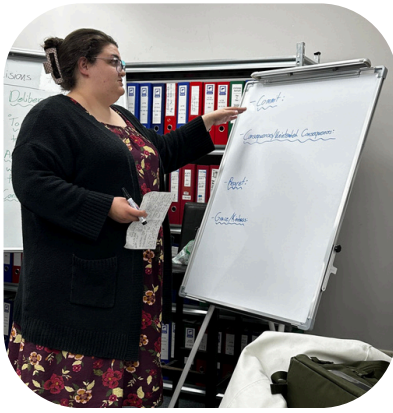


LETTERS FROM ELSEWHERE
