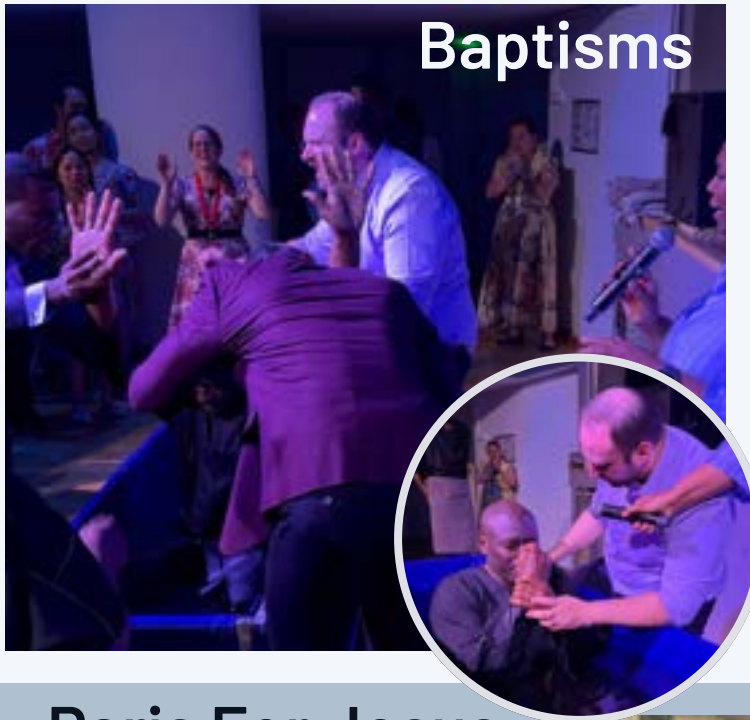


Alicia & Baptiste in Paris
