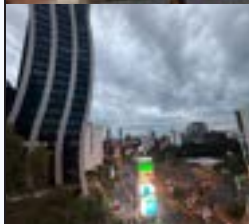
PRAYER REQUESTS

TRANSPORTATION

We have a unique need that has presented itself. In most major cities you are able to (at times) find an UberX for a bigger vehicle. Unfortunately, we have not found any here, so we are having to reserve and pay for two Ubers to get around day to day, school, ministry, grocery shopping, etc. Please pray that God would provide a more convenient solution as we often have long waits due to where our apartment is, are unable to walk to parts around us due to safety, and are having to spend double than originally planned and allotted.
