



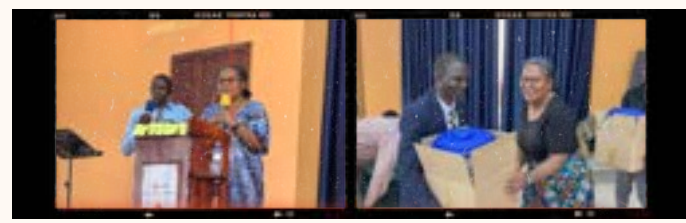

Teaching & Preaching

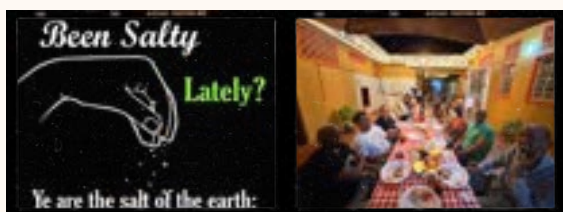
What a great time of renewal and encouragement at UACU's Kampal Regional Ladies Conference.

Josephine, the young lady who works at a shop near my house, decided to be baptized in Jesus' name. She was filled with the Holy Ghost while still in the water.

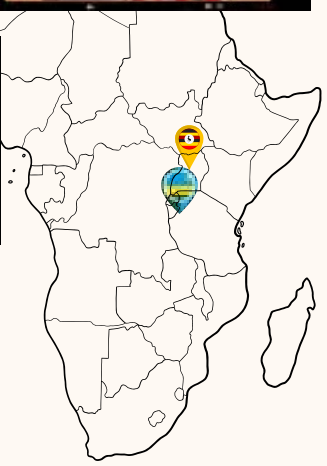
