



AUGUST REPORT – SENEGAL

- **22 baptisms of the Holy Spirit**
- **3 water baptisms in the name of Jesus Christ**
- **Several people delivered from unclean spirits**
- **Approximately 30 guests attended our services and various activities throughout the month**

The month of August was marked by the visit of a six-member team from Canada, accompanied by Rev. DieuDonné Kahozi, who came to support the missionary work in Senegal for ten days.

The team was actively involved in evangelism, the Children's Vacation Club, the seminar on Apostolic Identity, as well as missionary work in Casamance, in southern Senegal.

For three days, we welcomed 45 children, supervised by approximately 14 monitors. We witnessed a great move of the Holy Spirit. Several children, including some from Muslim families, were deeply touched by the presence of God for the first time. We had the joy of seeing 15 children receive the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

We also organized a seminar on the theme "A Threefold Cord," focusing on Apostolic identity. The teachings delivered by Rev. DieuDonné Kahozi helped strengthen the Church in the knowledge of the Word of God and reinforce everyone's convictions. Following these teachings, one person was baptized in water in the name of Jesus Christ.

Mission in Casamance

We traveled to Casamance, in southern Senegal, to meet a group of Senegalese believers with whom we share the same Apostolic doctrine.

2 people were baptized in water, and 5 received the Holy Spirit.

After several discussions, the main leader shared with us that, during a time of prayer and searching the Scriptures, God revealed to him that baptisms in the early Church were performed in the name of Jesus Christ and that receiving the Holy Spirit was accompanied by speaking in tongues.

This testimony deeply encouraged us and demonstrates that the Holy Spirit is truly at work in this region.

We pray that the Lord Jesus will bless this collaboration and that many souls will be saved in Casamance.
