Baptism in Ciudad del Este

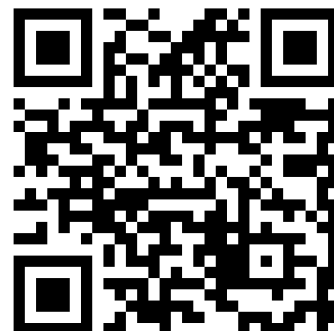
We are so thankful to report a baptism in Ciudad del Este, according to Acts 2:38! We are believing that revival will continue through out Paraguay!



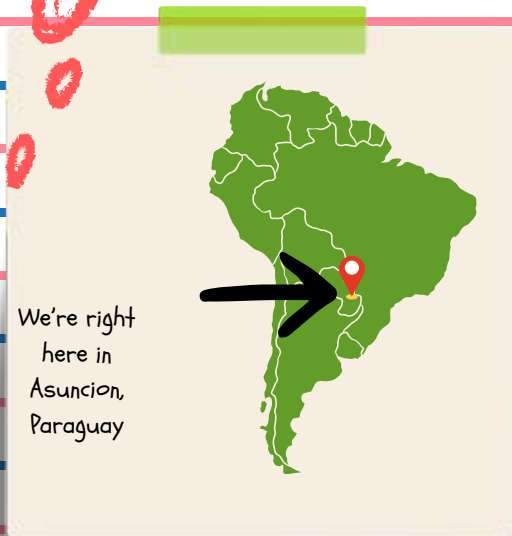
Luque with Rev. Bir

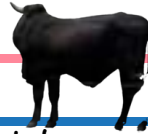
